## **CONTEST RULES:**



- Please make sure your prose is **no longer than 3000 words**, and poetry is **no more than 5 pages**. Because the winning entries will be read aloud, please **no profanity or gratuitous violence**. Those entries will either be disqualified or censored as needed.
- Entries will be judged by 1 or more people, depending on the number of entries. All decisions by judges and contest coordinator are final.
- Entry Fee: All children in grades 5-12 may enter for free, and as many times as they like.
- Contestants 18 or over are asked to make at least a \$10 donation to either Halloween in the Hills, or to West Virginia Writers Inc. This is simply to provide financial support for the contest and banquet to benefit the children. Any submissions from adults not accompanied by a donation will not be judged.
